



1997 Majella Shiraz

The Majella vineyard is situated on the eastern edge of the famous Coonawarra “red strip”. This wine was made from 100% Shiraz grapes grown on that vineyard.

The nose shows cinnamon and white pepper characters with some “cedary” oak aromas. Black pepper extends through the palate and leads to a soft, tannic finish.

Fermentation was completed in small oak barrels, and the wine was aged for a further 22 months in American oak hogsheads.
