

2009 Majella Shiraz

Variety: 100 % Shiraz Region: Coonawarra, South Australia

The Majella Shiraz first appeared in 1991 and has since acquired a reputation as one of Coonawarra's finest.

Dark red in colour with purple hues, the wine is redolent of cinnamon spice with overlays of cedary mocha oak. The palate shows great length, full of plums, cherries, blackberries and vanilla – creamy and sweet!

The tannins are quite soft and dusty, and complement the long, lingering finish.

The fermentation was completed in 300 litre barrels and the wine was then aged for a further 22 months in a blend of French and American oak.

We present it as a great example of Coonawarra Shiraz at its very best.
