



2002 Majella Cabernet

What more can we say about the Majella Cabernet? Universally regarded as one of Coonawarra's greatest wines it continues to win trophies and medals throughout Australia and the world.

The wine has a wonderful deep magenta colour with a rich nose, redolent of ripe plums, ever so slightly herbaceous and with just a hint of capsicum. The palate is true Coonawarra cabernet – very structured, with layers of blackberries and black fruits. Very rich and very complex.

The lingering finish is very dry and overlaid with “fine grain” tannins.

The wine was “barrel fermented” and then aged for about 22 months in French oak hogshead (300 litre barrels). It's a real winner!!
