What more can we say about the Majella Cabernet?

Universally regarded as one of Coonawarra's greatest wines, it continues to win trophies and medals throughout Australia and the world.

Dark red - almost black in colour, the nose leaps out exhibiting a very complex nose with hints of black fruits, blue fruits and violets.

This complexity carries over to the palate, rich, juicy and ribena-like, with plums and fruitcake characters showing through.

The finish is long and lingering with wonderful 'soft grain' tannins.

The wine was "barrel fermented" and then aged for about 22 months in French oak hogsheads (300 litre barrels). It's a real winner!!
