



1997 “The Malleea” by Majella

Made from 55% Cabernet Sauvignon, 45% Shiraz and selected from some very low bearing vines grown on the Majella vineyard in Coonawarra.

The nose shows a strong combination of spices and berries with lifted oak aromas.

The palate structure is very complex, with hints of ripe plums and a very long tannic finish.

The wine was barrel fermented and then aged for two years in new French Oak hogsheads.
